The season is a few events old now. Have things worked out the way you thought they would? Were you prepared? Did you do everything? What did you leave out? What did you leave off? What did you forget to take? I've suggested buying or downloading a rulebook. Did you? That little book may answer at least a few of the previous questions. First off, classing of the car is your responsibility and that's not always the easiest to do. A few things can bump you up one or two classes.

You should have an idea of how much the first events cost you. Is that cost sustainable with your budget? If not, how can you best spend your time and money? Did you do a driver's school? That should be on your list of events to run. You may want to lay low and let your wallet catch up if things are tight.

I hope the multitude of people walking the courses early is a sign of good habits. Did you take notes? Draw your own course map? Start an event journal? If not, it's food for thought. Success starts at home. Take advantage of the novice walk through even if you're no longer a novice. New ideas may present themselves from an experienced guide.

I know many people take advantage of the fun-runs, mainly for fun, but it could be a good test for changes. I've really missed good opportunities for doing that myself. I'd had a lot of fun in the regular session and had good people there to help me with adjustments but I didn't capitalize on the idea.

Don't forget to just ask around for advice. You may find several answers to the same question but if you can talk to someone with a similar car you'll be better off. After all a great set-up on the CRX that beats my Miata won't be the same set-up that works for my car to beat his. Also you may want to take advantage of our club's online forum. There's advice offered to questions and there are parts deals offered in the For Sale section.
